**Learning Focus :**

Reading - This weeks reading story is titled "Immigrant Children". In this story students will learn about the process, as well as the challenges faced by immigrants from other countries as they passed through Ellis Island. Grammar topics will include prepositional phrases, synonyms, and story vocabulary.

Spelling - This weeks spelling words can be found on page 101 of the Reading Skills practice book. Test number one will be taken on Wednesday, with test #2 on Friday.

Math - In math this week we will continue our study of area and perimeter. We will also be using area and perimeter in problem solving applications. Later in the week we will also review area and perimeter.
